Duties

Responsibilities may include recording member questions, and follow-up to ensure responses are provided by the Treaty Team.

Treaty Community Team members may also assist Treaty Team with regular monthly community meetings and other treaty events, as needed. Some travel is required within Kitselas communities and locally (Terrace / Thornhill).
